


- Read all instructions before installing or adjusting any Kargo Master rack or accessory.
- Different ladders will use a variety of different hook mounting locations and orientations.
- Ensure the ladder is securely held to rack prior to transportation.


# DO NOT EXCEED MANUFACTURERS WEIGHT CAPACITY FOR ROOF

#### **Adjustment Instructions**

- Locate the angled pads.
- Loosen the bolt on both front and rear ladder stop angled pads, adjust them all the way up, and tighten the nuts.




• Loosen the bolt that secures the front ladder stop to the cross member.









• Lower the clamping mechanism and load the ladder onto the rack.




- Raise the clamping mechanism and lock the handle in the handle latch.
- Press ladder against the rear clamping mechanism.
- Loosen the hardware on the back of front ladder stop angled pad.
- Pressing on the ladder towards the rear, adjust angled pad downwards until it is firmly against the ladder.









• Tighten the nut securing the angled pad to the ladder stop.




• Press the ladder towards the rear and the angle pads against the ladder rung, tighten the bolt securing the front ladder stop to the front bow.








- Loosen the bolt securing the angled pad to the clamping mechanism.
- Unlatch the handle from the handle latch and, while holding the clamping mechanism in place, adjust the angled pad downwards until it sits firmly against the top of the ladder.
- Secure the handle into the handle latch and tighten the nut.



• The ladder rack is now adjusted for the ladder. To adjust to a different ladder, repeat the process.





# **Angle Pad Orientations and Locations**




## **Clamp Mechanism Orientation and Angled Pad Positions**



#### **Examples of Ladder Clamps Firmly Against Ladder Rungs**

• The ladder hook should be positioned in a way so the hook clamps the ladder tight into place. A tight fit ensures the ladder cannot fall off the rack.



#### \*\* BE SURE THE LADDER HOOKS ARE FIRMLY AGAINST THE LADDER STEPS OR RUNGS. \*\*
